UNITED STUDENT STRIKE

"Dare to struggle; dare to win!"



DURING THE PAST WEEK, FOUR STUDENTS HAVE BEEN MURDERED AT KENT STATE, A USED CAR SALES-MAN ORDERED AN INVASION OF CAMBODIA, AMERIKAN IMPERIALIST ARMED FORCES CONTINUED REPRESSION OF THIRD WORLD LIBERATION MOVEMENTS, AND POLICE STATE TACTICS HAVE INCREASED ACROSS THE NATION.

THE TIME HAS COME TO STRIKE

AND TAKE ACTION TO END THESE INHUMAN TACTICS OF OPPRESSION AGAINST THE PEOPLE.
